

# Merry Christmas From All Of Us At EZ Face Painting

Here's a "Frosty" Face Painting Idea That Is Sure To Bring Out The Holiday Artist In Everyone.

**Step 1.** Begin with FDA-compliant Face Paints. Acrylics, tempera or other household or craft paints are not recommended. (see resources)

**Step 2.** Paint an outline of Frosty in royal blue.



**Step 3.** Using a paint brush or sponge, fill in area around snowman's body with royal blue.

**Step 4.** Paint the snowman's hat in black and if desired, add a red heart and band around hat. Continue to fill in with black.



**Step 5.** Fill in the body of the snowman in white. Letting dry for a few seconds, add the buttons in various colors. Add stars/snowflakes over blue background color.



**Step 6.** Complete the snowman with eyes and smile in black. Add an orange carrot nose.
